

Military Service of the Descendants Of George Cosby, Loyalist

George Cosby, Loyalist was a Private in [Major James Rogers] King's Rangers from the inception of the 2nd Battalion and was stationed throughout the war at Fort St Johns, Quebec until it was mustered out from camp at Machiche, near Montreal in Quebec. He died in 1806 but some of descendants served in subsequent wars.
