**12 a)** 1846 Brown's Directory of Toronto City and the Home District, Chinguacousy Twp., Pg 22 – lists Cornelius VANWYCK and Adam SNIDER living in close proximity in Chinguacousy Twp.

**12 b)** 1851 Census – CW – Peel Co. – Chinguacousy Twp – C-11746 – pgs 59 & 60 – line 4

- Shows Maria VANWICK (age 19) living in the home of Cornelius and Matilda VANWICK, identified as a member of the household, single

**12 c)** 1851 Census – CW – Peel Co. – Chinguacousy Twp – C-11746 – pgs 183 & 184 – line 25

- Shows Philip L. SNIDER (age 25) living in the home of Adam and Rachel SNIDER, identified as a member of the household, single

**12 d)** 1861 Census – CW – Waterloo Co. – Waterloo Twp – C-1078 – pg 26 – Lines 1 – 5

- Lists Philip L. SNYDER age 35, born in Peel (age consistent with 1851 Census)

- Lists a son, Adam H SNYDER, age 8, born in Peel (name consistent with father of Philip L. SNYDER)

- Lists a daughter, Rachel SNYDER, age 2, born in Waterloo (name consistent with mother of Philip L. SNYDER)

Age is precisely that of a child reported to have died in the 1861 Census. *The name "Cornelius" is consistent with father of Maria Van Wyck, as listed in the 1851 Census and completes the naming pattern of the first four children, who were named after both sets of parents*

- Death Notice for Cornelius SNYDER, virtually identical to the Obituary from Dumfries Reformer.

- Identifies her as wife of P. L. Snyder
- Says she was born in Chinguacousy Twp (found there with her parents in 1851 census as outlined above)

- Identifies her parents as Philip SNYDER and Maria VAN WYCK, both born Ontario
- Cites her birth date as 18 March 1864 in Waterloo (identical to baptism registration)
- Informant is her husband, John FERGUSON
