John Roger enlisted in the Loyal American Regiment-27 Mar 1777--a prisnor of war of the Americans from 16 Jul 1779-1 Dec 1782. Came to New Brunswick with other Brothers in 1783-[United Empire Loyalist] Before leaving New York , he married Abigail Brewer of Dutch ancestry By 1839 John Roger had died,wife Abigail still living,listed as a widow of a Veteran and receiving a pension. In 1843 her age was given as as 79 yrs. which would put her birth date at 1764.

Roger was a drummer boy in Loyal American Regiment -1803 listed as single,probably never marr.
- VII **Elijah Tompkins #182** \* 1762, Of,Westchester New York, † Car Co New Brunswick,  
Elijah ,no information on him.
- VIII **Joseph Tompkins #257** \* 1764, † 17 Apr 1778,  
Joseph enlisted 27 Mar 1777 and died in service.

Signed by following brothers and sisters John Tompkins and wife Esther [Gee]--Roger Tompkins and wife Elizabeth [Guiggy]--Nehemiah Tompkins and wife Margaret [Hopkins]--Samuel Farley and wife Abigail [Tompkins]--John Donnelly and wife Sarah [Tompkins]-- Charles Boyer and wife Elizabeth [Tompkins] --Mary Tompkins.

John TOMPKINS, b. abt 1700, shares 400 acres with son, Roger Tompkins who is also listed as a grantee.

Two other LAR men included in this grant are Stephen Griffin, Capt. Randle's Co. - 100 acres and Sgt. Theodore Valleau, Capt. Robinson's Co. - 500 acres.

Others were: Joseph Cunliffe - 700 acres, William Ferril - 200 acres, Alexander McDonald - 700 acres and William Parker - 100 acres.
