WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that July 22, 2012, shall be known as

Lt. Governor Stephan Point (2012) proclaimed July 22nd annually as BC Loyalist Day.



This particular day was chosen due to the inscription shown on the rock marking "Alex Mackenzie from Canada by land 22nd July 1793". The first documented person to cross the North American continent and reaching the Pacific. Shown below and located in Sir Alexander Mackenzie Provincial Park.
