

Loyally Yours – 100 Years of The UELAC

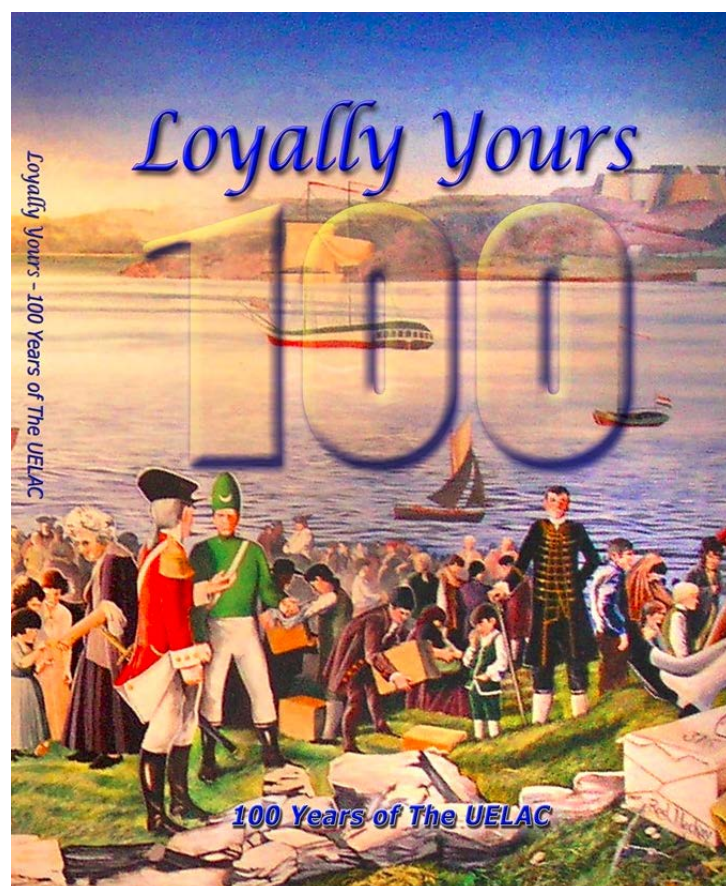
One hundred years ago this month a dream came true. The United Empire Loyalists' Association of Canada was born - incorporated on 27 May 1914 - following a century of searching for a common voice to represent the memory of the Loyalists.
