Branch Reports

Activities Report:

- Member of the Branch Board of Directors, Edwina Jenne Bougie UE, represented the Branch at the Commemoration of the Battle of Eccles Hill, organized by the Missisquoi Historical Society and held on site on 27 May 2022. A part of a raid into Canadian territory from the United States by the Fenians in 1870, the Battle of Eccles Hill was designated a National Historic Site of Canada in 1923.
- The 53rd Annual General Meeting and Luncheon was held on Saturday, 11 June 2022, at la Salle de reception du Dépanneur Rouge in Knowlton, QC. About 23 members and guests participated. The Annual General Meeting was held after an delicious meal. The meeting adjourned at 3h30 p.m.
- Members of the Board of Directors, Adelaide Lanktree UE, Jo-Ann Savage UE and Michel Racicot, represented the Branch at the E. John Chard Plaque Unveiling Ceremony that took place at the UEL Heritage Centre & Park, in Adolphustown, Ontario, on 19 June 2022. Guests of the Bay of Quinte Branch, the 5 Branches who inherited from the estate of the late John Chard, patron of our Branch, were represented: Bicentennial – Kawartha – Kingston – St. Lawrence – Sir John Johnson Centennial. Also present at the ceremony were Patricia Groom UE, UELAC President and Bill Russell UE. There was a very good participation along with re-enactors and many participants were dressed in UEL outfits including Adelaide and Jo-Ann. There was also a flag raising ceremony and wreaths were laid by each of the Branches at the cenotaph. Adelaide and Jo-Ann laid the wreath for our Branch. This ceremony was followed by a minute of silence, a musket volley and cannon firing. Following the ceremonies, a UEL church service was held at the St. Albans Church across the street from the park. After the church service, we all gathered at the UEL Heritage Centre and Park- Adolphustown Hall for tea, punch, cake and cookies. A very beautiful day.

- Wednesday 10 August 2022, a visit and picnic took place on the site of Sir John Johnson Burial Vault at Mont-Saint-Grégoire. Fifteen members accepted the invitation. A short presentation on the history and restoration of the burial vault was given by Michel Racicot. The weather cooperated with us.
