Winter has arrived; this is a good time to look back on our Branch different activities in 2023

Branch Reports

Activities Report:

- The 54th Annual General Meeting and Luncheon was held on Saturday, 10 June 2023, at the Odd Fellows' Lodge in Knowlton, QC. Twenty-one members and guests were present for the luncheon which started at 12:10 p.m. followed by the Annual General Meeting.
- On Friday, 16 June 2023, we had the special visit of our Branch Honorary President, Sir Guy Johnson, 8th Bt. of New York and his wife, Lady Marie Louise Johnson, at Mount Johnson (Mont Saint-Grégoire), the site of the burial vault of Sir John Johnson, 2nd Bt. of New York. It was their first time visiting the burial vault of his ancestor. About 30 members and guests were present to greet them. It was a great day.
- Reprint of the branch book "The Loyalists of the Eastern Townships" 500 copies of the third edition of the book were printed and presently being distributed to members, historical societies, libraries, etc. A few bookstores have the book on sale. Branch member Ross Gledhill has taken charge of the distributing process of the book. Already, about 300 copies of the book have been distributed.
- On Saturday, 21 October 2023, at the Odd Fellows' Lodge in Knowlton, QC, twenty-four members and friends participated at our Fall Luncheon. Our guest speaker was Matthew Farfan, Executive Director of Quebec Anglophone Heritage Network (QAHN). Matthew gave us with a very interesting PowerPoint presentation on the Golden Rule Lodge No 5, founded in 1803 and one of the oldest Masonic lodges in Quebec and the beginnings of Freemasonry in Quebec.
