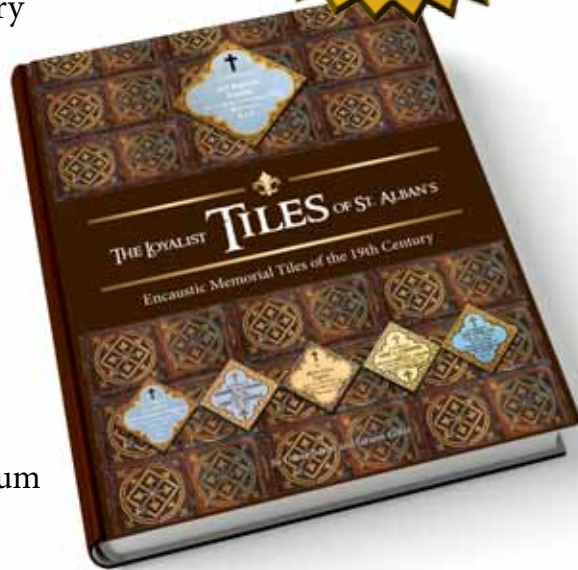

Published with the assistance of an Ontario Trillium Foundation Grant, this 150 page book with more than 80 coloured photographs includes:

- ◆ The story of how this lovely neo-gothic, stone church, dedicated to United Empire Loyalists, came to be built in 1884 in the small farming community of Adolphustown.
- ◆ A description of the process used in the manufacture of the sixty-four encaustic (in-laid clay) Loyalist memorial tiles that encircle the interior of the church. These unique tiles were made in the Minton family pottery works in Stoke-on-Trent, U.K.
- ◆ Coloured photos of the sixty-four tiles, each accompanied by a well-researched biography of the individual memorialized.
