UNITED EMPIRE LOYALIST VANCOUVER BRANCH COLLECTION TO BE DEDICATED

Over the past few decades, there was a lot of fine librarianship done by United Empire Loyalist Association of Canada, Vancouver Branch members acquiring and organizing this collection of books and related materials. They produced an Excel spreadsheet that contained all needed standard bibliographic fields. Each book was given an accession number and a property stamp. As it became evident that the collection had outgrown any member's spare room, the books, pamphlets and binders were reluctantly boxed and stored. Discussion and strategy over a number of years led to the offer of the collection to the BCGS last August.

Members checked the boxes of library books and determined which boxes held unauthorized photocopies of books or journal articles that should not remain part of the collection. Following that, the remaining total of 688 books was compared with the BCGS catalogue. It was determined that a good percentage of the UE collection would be new to the BCGS and would greatly add to the research experience of those visiting their library in Surrey. To highlight this fact and other details, seven 8.5 x 11 inch full colour slides from a PowerPoint presentation were provided to BCGS Board for their meeting.

The Branch was hopeful that this was our



answer. Then, on October 30, 2015 we

heard the good news via an email from Judith – "It is with great pleasure that I am able to tell you that the BCGS Board last night voted unanimously to accept the UEL Library Collection. It was also decided that the Collection be kept separate from the BCGS regular shelves and displayed independently."

The UELAC Vancouver Branch rejoiced at this announcement! Moving day was dry and crisp. A number of Branch members were on hand at the storage unit to assist with the move and to follow the truck to Surrey. When the boxes were settled in the available spaces we enjoyed a tour of the library and research area to ensure that we were all aware of the value of the full Walter Draycott Library.

The Branch will maintain an Affiliate Society membership in the BCGS and members will have free access during regular opening hours just by presenting their current UE membership card.

The Branch executive and many members look forward to being at the unveiling and dedication of the collection in the Walter Draycott Library when we will celebrate the common work we do of knowing and understanding our ancestors and the Canadian history we share and love.
