#### Directions to the Westmount Library:

Arriving by the 401 from the west.

take the Talbotville Exit and go north to the village of Lambeth.

At the light at the four corners in the village of Lambeth (Royal Bank on your right and old Anglican church on your left) your will turn right.

Continue on this road until you reach Wonderland Road. There is a TSC store near this corner on the right. You will turn left and should get over into the right hand lane once you turn.

You will pass the bus terminal and when you see the A&W sign on the right you will want to prepare to turn. Just past the A&W is the library and the entrance to the parking area is to the north of this. The library will not open until 9 am.

Arriving by the 401 from the east:

The easiest way is to take the Exeter Road exit. It is past the Highbury exit and just before the St. Thomas exit. Taking this exit avoids left hand turns onto Exeter Road in the traffic. If you miss this exit you can use the Talbotville exit as above.

Stay on Exeter Road, heading west, going past Len's Mills store, through the light, and past several industrial small plazas. You will come to another light which has a playing field on the north west corner. Just past this is the light at Wonderland where you will turn right.

You will pass the bus terminal and when you see the A&W sign on the right you will want to prepare to turn. Just past the A&W is the library and the entrance to the parking area is to the north of this. The library will not open until 9 am.
