### Conference:

The Conference is back, and it's bigger than last year as 9 authors/historians will present on various topics. The Conference portion will be a day and half, starting on Saturday June 11<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 AM and will conclude on Sunday June 12<sup>th</sup> by 1:00 PM. The Conference will be held at the Fulton-Montgomery Community College Auditorium, which is located in the Visual Arts and Communications Building. The College is located at 2805 State Highway 67, Johnstown, NY 12095. Attendees will receive a boxed lunch with beverage and beverages/refreshments (coffee, water, soda, etc.) will be served throughout the Conference.

#### **Mohawk Country Bus Tour #1:**

These sites include the following: Fort Johnson Historic Landmark, Fort Hunter (Schoharie Crossing State Historic Site), Johnson Hall State Historic Site, the Drumm House, the Tryon County Courthouse, the Colonial Cemetery, the Fort Johnstown Jail, the Johnstown Battlefield, the Montgomery County History & Archives, the Kateri Indian Museum (Liberty Pole Site).

Bus Tour #2 will depart from the Fulton-Montgomery Community College located at 2805 State Highway 67, Johnstown, NY 12095 at 8:45 AM. There will be a lunch stop at a local restaurant at your own expense.
