Speaker Bio:

We're honoured to welcome the UELAC's first Honorary Fellow, Mr. Nathan Tidridge.

Nathan is a recipient of the Queen's Golden Jubilee Medal and was one of six Ontarians presented with a Diamond Jubilee Medal by His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales.

Nathan has also been awarded the Premier's Award for Teaching Excellence (Teacher of the Year), Charles Baillie Award for Excellence in Secondary School Teaching, the Sharon Enkin Award for Excellence in Holocaust Education, the national 2013 Canadian Royal Heritage Award, and the 2017 Flamborough-Glanbrook Nation Builder's Award.



In 2015, the Rt. Hon. Stephen Harper presented Nathan with one of fifty specially created flags in recognition of his “tremendous contributions to our great country.” In 2017 Nathan was awarded the Meritorious Service Medal by Governor General Julie Payette highlighting his work in understanding the complex relationships between Indigenous Peoples and the Crown.

The United Empire Loyalists' Association of Canada highlighted his work by making Nathan their first Honorary Fellow in 2018.
