Other folks in attendance were clad in cultural and ceremonial attire.

Dr. Point's career and education journey has paralleled the development of the UFV from college to university. She brings a wealth of experience to this prestigious office. Her contributions to the University are legion as well as the Chilliwack Community as a whole. To mention a few: many years with the Fraser Valley College, now the Fraser Valley University, as a teacher, scholar, mentor, administrator, board member, a passionate leader, role model. DR. GWEN POINT NEW CHANCELLOR OF UFV

Dr. Gwen Point was installed as Chancellor of the University of the Fraser Valley at a ceremony at its Chilliwack campus at Canada

Education Park on February 4, 2015. The installation ceremony was attended by more than 400 dignitaries and special guests, including the Honourable Judith Guichon, Lieutenant Governor of British Columbia.
Dr. Point takes over from Dr. Brian Minter, who was UFV's first Chancellor and served two terms stretching from 2008 to 2014. The <u>Chancellor</u> is the ceremonial head of the University of the Fraser Valley and serves as a member of the Board of Governors and the <u>Senate</u>. Dr. Point will also preside over UFV's Convocation, conferring degrees, diplomas, and certificates, and serve as an ambassador for UFV at major events. The Chancellor is appointed by the <u>UFV Board of Governors</u> upon the recommendation of the Alumni Association and consultation with the UFV Senate.

The new Chancellor's connection to the University of the Fraser Valley stretches back decades, starting in the early 1980s when she and her husband Steven (former Lieutenant Governor of British Columbia and a B.C. provincial court judge) took university-level courses there.

Following luncheon, a presentation on Irish Palatine Loyalists was given by President Shirley Dargatz UE. A loyalist certificate presented to Leon Merchant UE for new Loyalist Caleb Powell and it was also announced that Pat Huth UE had been awarded her certificate for Loyalist Jesse Bigelow.

Then member Chris Hay UE introduced us to his first grandchild, Kaeden James Hay born March 13, 2015. (Parents are Kevin Hay UE and Christie Kromar Hay). Next he then produced a portrait of his Loyalist ancestor Maj. Richard Witham Stockton of the New Jersey Volunteers (7th Great Grandfather of Kaeden) which he obtained from descendants of the Stockton family who had remained in the US. This picture was painted by Henry Benbridge who also painted Benjamin Franklin. While it is listed by the Smithsonian Museum, its actual present location remains unknown. But a book named "Early American Painting" by F.F. Sherman published in 1932 is the last known reference to its existence. Chris also uncovered a great story about Maj. Stockton written in the book "Kidnapping the Enemy" - The special operations to capture Generals Lee and Prescott (of the Revolutionary Army); in which Maj. Stockton played a key roll. The story is fascinating and we have included a picture of the front cover in case anyone is interesting in finding it. Great Sleuthing Chris!
