Abbotsford LDS Family History Day

On Saturday, May 2nd our branch participated in the Family History Day at the LDS Church in Abbotsford. We had a number of displays on Loyalist Families and distributed our brochure and application form. On hand to answer questions were Shirley Dargatz UE, Judy

Scholz UE, Koralee Heibner UE, Jan Ouellet and her friend Emily Tomson.

Contacts were made and we have already sent out emails to those who showed an interest in joining our branch and searching for their Loyalist ancestor.

The school was opened in November of 1909 with 17 students in grades 1 thru 6 registered. The first teacher was Miss M.E. Cowan. The last students said goodbye to the school in December of 1941. The Promontory Women's Institute took over the building in 1956, restored it in the 1970's. Since 1976 it has been the Hobby Hill Pre-school. This building still stands in its original location. The area's first white settlers, Edward and Elizabeth Thornton donated the lot from their settlement of 260 acres on the Promontory hillside. Edward Thornton is a direct descendant of Loyalist John Thornton of Prince William, York Co., New Brunswick. John Thornton arrived in N.B in 1787. He served under General Cunningham during the American Revolution. Edward Thornton came to the Chilliwack area in the 1890's and was one of the pioneers honoured at our branches dedication ceremony at the Chilliwack Museum last October. This building was named a heritage building and added to the BC Register of Historic

Places in August of 1988.
